• Rent or purchase from a local music store – flyers are available


• Many stores offer rent to own programs

Essential Elements Book 1 (orange stripe):



Attendance and Preparation/Participation

• Attend all lessons, even without instrument

• Help your child develop good habits early

Practicing

• Consistency is key

• Listen to your child practice

• Ask about strategies to work on a difficult section

• Music should be repeated many times
